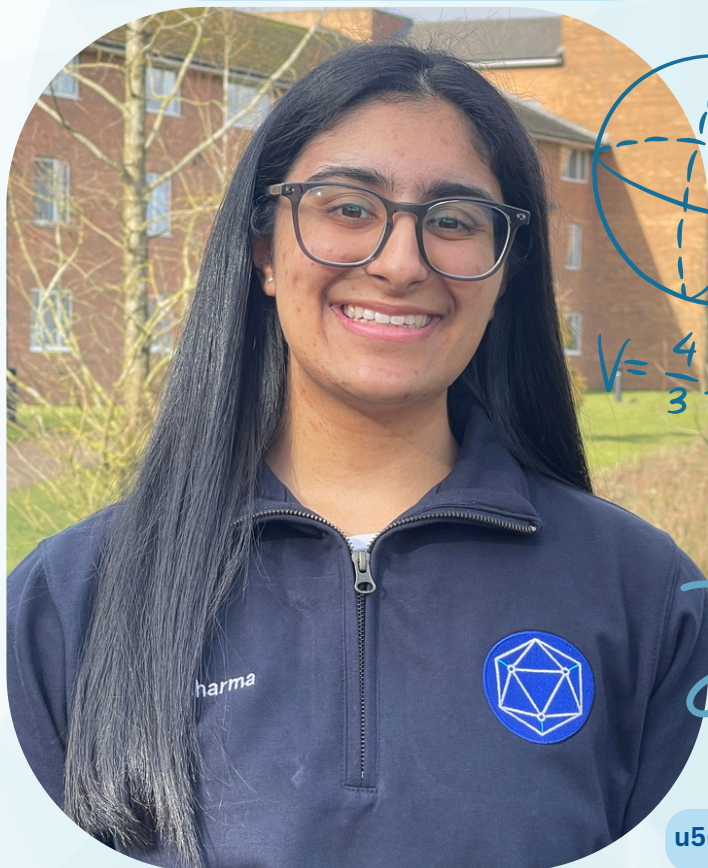


Deeya for Welfare and Equal Opportunities
